

Declaration on Packaging Placed on the Market in Compliance with Regulation (EU) 2025/40 (PPWR)

Torraspapel monitors and assesses the implementation of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on packaging and packaging waste (PPWR), which entered into force on 11 February 2025 and will become generally applicable from 12 August 2026.

This statement relates exclusively to the **packaging placed on the market by Torraspapel** for the dispatch, protection, bundling and transportation of all products manufactured by Torraspapel.

In this context, Torraspapel uses different types of packaging materials, including, as applicable, wooden pallets, kraft or wrapping paper, cardboard, edge protectors, boxes, sheets, interleaves, strapping, films, tapes, labels and other ancillary components.

Torraspapel hereby states that it has been identifying such packaging materials for some time in order to collect and review the technical and documentary information relating to these packaging components and progressively adapt its documentation in line with the implementation timetable established under the Regulation.

Substances and PFAS

For most products marketed by Torraspapel, the packaging used for the dispatch, protection, bundling and transportation of its products is neither designed nor intended to come into contact with food. Consequently, the PFAS restrictions set out in the Regulation do not apply to such packaging.

In the case of papers explicitly marketed for food contact applications, Torraspapel manages these products in accordance with their intended use and the applicable legislation governing food contact materials.

Torraspapel does not intentionally add PFAS to such packaging materials. Furthermore, based on the technical information collected to date, no evidence has been identified indicating that such packaging exceeds the PFAS limits established under Regulation (EU) 2025/40, which will become applicable from 12 August 2026.

Torraspapel continues to expand and review the technical information provided by its suppliers in order to better document and communicate compliance with applicable substance-related requirements to its customers.
